The purpose of this competition is to engage youth in critical thinking and creative expression to raise awareness and celebrate the evolution of African Americans in America from 1920 - 2020.

Competition:

Participants may select any topic including, music, art, fashion, dance, military, politics, etc. Once topic is selected, participants are asked to submit an original creation (visual art, performance art, or written expression) that depicts their understanding of how African Americans have evolved within the selected topic in the last 100 years in American Society.

Judging:

Creations will be judged on:

- Creativity
- Accuracy and use of Black History facts from 1920 -2020
- Clarity of evolution within a topic (creations must show representation of specific progress over time).

Entry Categories & Prizes:

Each category will have a 1st and 2nd place honoree. 1st place honorees will receive a \$100 cash prize, submission featured during a service and on social media platforms. 2nd place honoree will receive \$50 cash prize.
