- 3. Plans to attend a four-year accredited college or university.
 - Dependents of members of the PWSC-NPHC are not eligible to apply for this scholarship.

II. Official Transcript

Please provide an official transcript from your high school counselor or principal. Make sure it indicates the most current grade point average (GPA). Your high school counselor or principal must certify documentation in the appropriate space. The transcript must be received in a sealed envelope or via email directly from your school.

III. Copy of 2022 IRS Filing

Please provide a copy of the 2022 Federal Tax Filing that shows your parent(s) name, address and adjusted gross income. Please black out the social security number. This documentation is needed to verify the income. Scoring is based on financial need, academics and contributions to the school and the community.

IV. Recommendation Form

Please provide two recommendations. Give the attached recommendation forms to a teacher or counselor to complete and return before the submission deadline via mail or email provided.

V. High Quality Photo

Please provide a high-quality photo of passport size (2 inches x 2 inches) or larger. No photo proofs will be accepted, and the applicant must be alone in the photo. Senior class photos, or professional headshots are preferred. **Please give us permission to post on social media, if selected.**

VI. Essay Topic

Complete a written, typed essay (1000 words or no less than 400, double spaced, Arial, 12-point font), on the topic: "How will you benefit from receiving the PWSC-NPHC", Jermaine Jackson, Ph.D. Scholarship award?"
